

Essay as one of the popular types of writings

Stage 1. We are working on the theme of the essay

This is the most important aspect that students should pay attention to. It often happens that you come across an amazing essay, competent, detailed. But you have to rate it low because it is not written on the topic.

The methodology offers such techniques that will help teach children to separate broad and narrow themes and correctly formulate the theme of the composition.

Stage 2. We define the boundaries of the theme and formulate the main idea

Here's another common mistake. So, here is a broad, general topic. Do not try to "embrace the immensity." Choose three or four examples and on their basis reveal the topic.

Reception, developing the ability to formulate an idea.

Choose one common topic and ask students to offer as many ideas as possible to develop that topic.

And, on the contrary-for a narrow topic, students should pick up as many ideas of its development and generalization as possible.

Stage 3. Making a plan of composition

Plan - "alpha and omega" any compositions, so as he sets framework and helps logically consistently to Express their thought.

Any composition, regardless of the type and genre, contains three main components: introduction, main part and conclusion.

But the stage of drawing up the plan can be carried out before or after the collection of material. It happens that the student has chosen a topic, outlined the boundaries and formulated the main idea, and what to write about-does not represent. Then it is better to collect the material first, and then make a plan. The main thing is that the preparation of the plan does not take place after the writing of the essay.

Stage 4. Collect material

The most difficult stage of the work, which allows you to form the basis of the future composition.

To begin with, it is necessary to discuss with the students that different types of compositions have their own language characteristics. So, adjectives, participles and nouns are important for the composition-description. In this form of writing, everything is built in response to the question "What..."

Verbs and nouns are important for the composition-narrative, since often these works are devoted to the description of an event, action.

Stage 5. Writing an essay

After the plan is made and the material is collected, we proceed directly to the writing of the essay.

Write on draft. Some teachers do not pay attention to the design of the draft. Meanwhile, this is very important, because many students write in drafts as they would write a finished essay. This option does not allow corrections and corrections (unless spelling errors).

Methodists advise to leave the introduction "for later", and write it after the main part is written. This technique will allow you to make a competent introduction, which, indeed, will set the theme and tone of the entire composition.

Step 6. Checking essays

After the essay is written in a draft, it is necessary to conduct a check. Typical mistakes: spelling, punctuation, stylistic, speech.

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
